Raytheon awards multi-year 13.9 million contract to build Prime Power Units.

Raytheon IDS has selected Milton CAT to produce Power Generation components for their ANTPY-2 Radar System.

Milford, MA – According to company officials, Milton CAT Power Systems, a division of the Milford, Massachusetts -based company, will provide the project management, engineering and services to manufacture the 1.3 mW Prime Power Unit (PPU) mobile generator systems for the next ANTPY-2 radar supplied to the US Missile Defense Agency (MDA).

“These PPU’s include Caterpillar diesel engines, control panels, cooling systems, enclosures and heavy duty trailer subsystems to provide critical power to the weapon system for tracking and defending against missile threats,” states Bucky Brennan, Milton CAT’s Military and Special Projects Sales Manager.

Brennan explains that work under the contract will be performed in Milford and at subcontractor locations in E.
